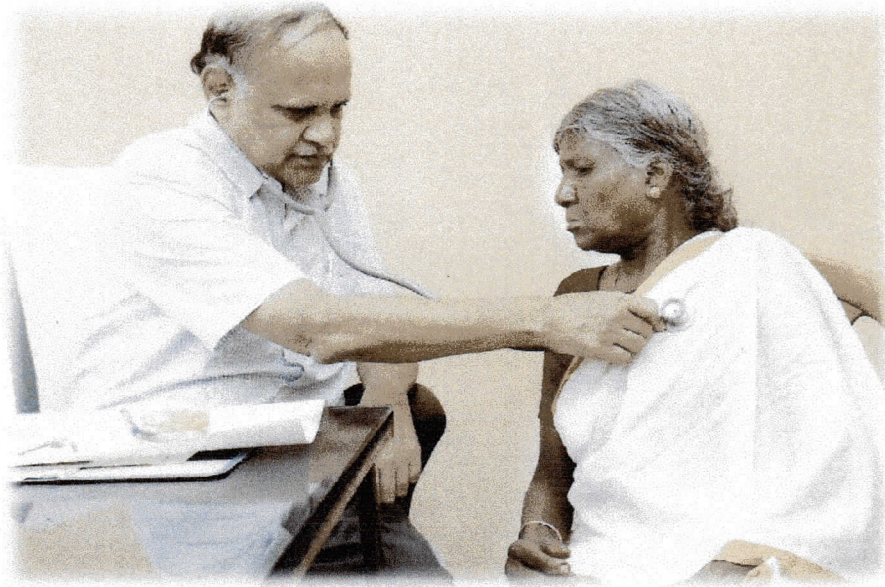

1) Four full time doctors including Dr. Dhananjay Divakar Sagdeo Padmasree as Chief Medical Officer and four visiting doctors are rendering their service in our hospital. Dental, Cardiology, Neurology, TB and Sickle cell Anemia departments are available. Ayurveda and Homeo and Naturopathy system of treatment are also available. With the financial assistance of Seva International ,we could able to establish and set up a new ICU, re-arrange modern IP wards, Clinical laboratory and Ambulance service. Besides these we could able to provide mobile dispensary services (two mobile units) throughout the year in the villages and tribal area of Wayanad District by arranging various medical camps and this year we have conducted 276 such free medical camps.

SWASTHYA MITHRA PROJECT.

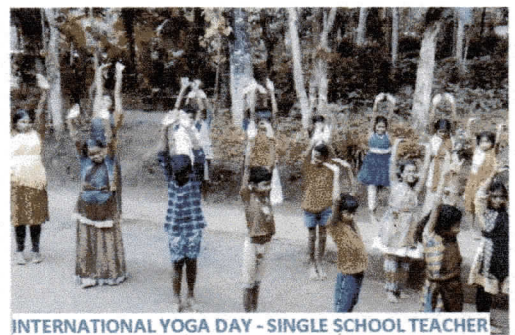
We have started this project through swasthyamithra with intent to render and assure health services to all the peoples of the villages including the hut men of the inner villages of the tribal areas and it has successfully been continuing for the last 25 years. Specially trained women have been doing the service of touch with the members of villages which are particularly assigned for them. By their routine visit they can be able to identify the problematic areas and take precautionary steps as well as to give primary treatments for the people of the villages for their minor ailments and can bring the sick persons to the hospitals who are in need of high degree of care and treatment. By organizing awareness camps and medical camps at various localities in the villages and tribal areas by the swasthyamithras, enable us to provide different types of medical services at the doorsteps of the poor peoples. This year about 11751 patients were given primary medical services and other health services through this project.

GRAMEENA VIDHYA KERNDRAM, SINGLE TEACHERS SCHOOLS, WITH THE ASSISTANCE OF TRIBAL INTEGRATED DEVELOPMENT AND EDUCATION MUMBAI TRUST (TIDE).



This project has been implemented by the Swami Vivekananda Medical Mission among the children of 125 selected tribal villages of Wayanad District with the aid, assistance and advice of the TIDE, a Mumbai based Charitable trust

This project primarily focus on the children's primary education and to prevent dropping out of the students and to inspire them more enthusiastic to the studies by integrating academic and other items for their physical and mental health. Specially trained lady teachers are rendering this services having the duration of 2 hours a day. Approximately 2000 students are getting the benefits of this service from the village schools. The parents of regular students are



also getting awareness classes through this scheme .In every year, about 75 students are getting high score in their SSLC Examination. Many old students of these centers have attained distinguished jobs and some of them in their higher studies.

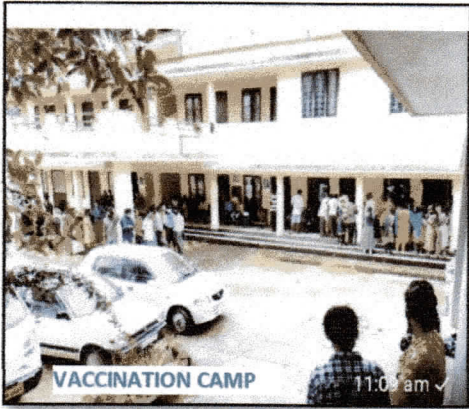
The cultural classes conducted once in week in the village schools is being designated as children cultural centers'. Artistic and cultural values of the children are being inculcated and the spirit of patriotism and moral values are being nurtured through 1 to 2 hour duration classes. Suitable curriculum have been developed to achieve this very objectives including recreational programmes and counseling etc. The teachers of the village schools themselves mending the cultural classes too. About 1800 ştudents are being participated in this weekly cultural programmes.

SREE SANKARA VIDYA NIKETHAN-(UP SCHOOL CHERUKARA).



This school has been functioning in cherukara village in Mananthavadi Taluk 2002 and the school was started in the year... then there was no other schools in and around six kilometers of such a remote tribal area.90 out of 130 students are from tribal population and the rest are from socially and economically backward families .Pupil are imparting value based education along with modern education with a view to mould them patriotic and a perfect citizen Physical training, special training in music etc. are also included in the curriculum, four language are included even in the primary level (English, Malayalam, hindi, Sanskrit) and the study from this school is completely free.

COVID RELATED SERVICES.



We have arranged help desks in all the panchayath centers of the district even at the beginning stage of the covid 19 spreading, which could expedite the execution of our health services at the very bottom level. Activities like arrangement of free medical camps ,distribution of preventive medicines, sanitation ,free ambulance service and conducting of awareness camps were carriedout. Supplied free preventive medicine for 7600 persons and arranged 196 free medical camps. 1051 houses and more than 100 institutions were sanitized.

More than 2000 families were supplied food kits. Awareness classes including video presentation were conducted to parents in 112 villages to prevent the spreading of corona among the children and arranged many vaccination camps at different localities in co-operation with the state health departments.

MANAGEMENTS

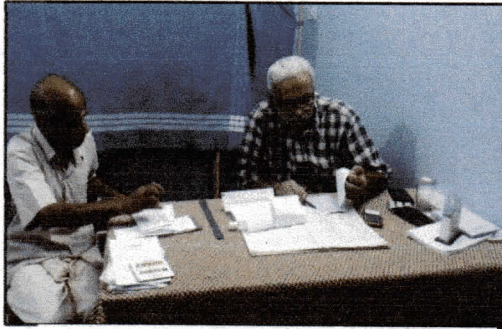
